The institute will adopt a thematic approach mirroring the content of Primary Source's own sourcebook for teaching imperial China, *The Enduring Legacy of Ancient China*. Topics will include early mythology and philosophy, family life and the common people, and China's rich artistic traditions. Content presentations and workshops will be offered by several of the scholars and master teachers who contributed to the book.
